School Annual Education Report (AER) Holbrook Elementary

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Holbrook Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Tom Talmadge for assistance.

For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

Holbrook school is different to surrounding schools as it is neither a Elementary nor a Middle School. Holbrook is a small family like environment with only one section of each grade level ranging from Kindergarten to 8th grade. Our Kindergarten to 5th grade are

self-contained with one classroom teacher while our middle school age students move from class to class as a traditional middle school would.

We are a small school education approximately 200 amazing students each year with a highly qualified staff. Not only will students at Holbrook receive support from their wonderful general educational teacher, but we also offer support with our Resource Room, Reading Specialist and two Multilanguage Learner teachers.

Need Extra support? Outside of the realm of general education, Holbrook has a lot to offer. We have recently established both a ASD Categorical and MoCl room in the building. Currently the room are at capacity for students and fully staffed. Along with the self-contained room we service inclusion students with support from our Special Education via our Resource room teacher.

Hungry? 100% of Holbrook's students are eligible for free and reduce lunch and healthy snacks program. 95% of our student population are considered Multilanguage Learners as the majority of our students are from Yemeni or Bengali descent. As of this year we have rostered a few students from Ukraine and Russia.

What to expect? Here at Holbrook our primary initiatives is to use every available resource to close the education gaps that are currently in place for our students due to uncontrollable circumstance. We are doing this by using the resources we have available provided by the Michigan Department of Education and the Hamtramck Public school district in combination with our implementation of the MTSS process to identify and work on specific individual student needs. This process focusses on the not just academics, but the whole child rather.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

- 1. Students are assigned to schools geographically, however parents are permitted to request placement at other schools within the district.
- 2. The 3-5 year School Improvement Plan has been completed and submitted to the State of Michigan for approval.
- 3. There are no specialized schools in the District.
- 4. The core curriculum is aligned to the state model and can be accessed on the district website (www.hamtramckschools.org) or in hard copy at the main office of the school. Teachers have a copy of the curriculum and their instructional delivery in the classroom is aligned.
