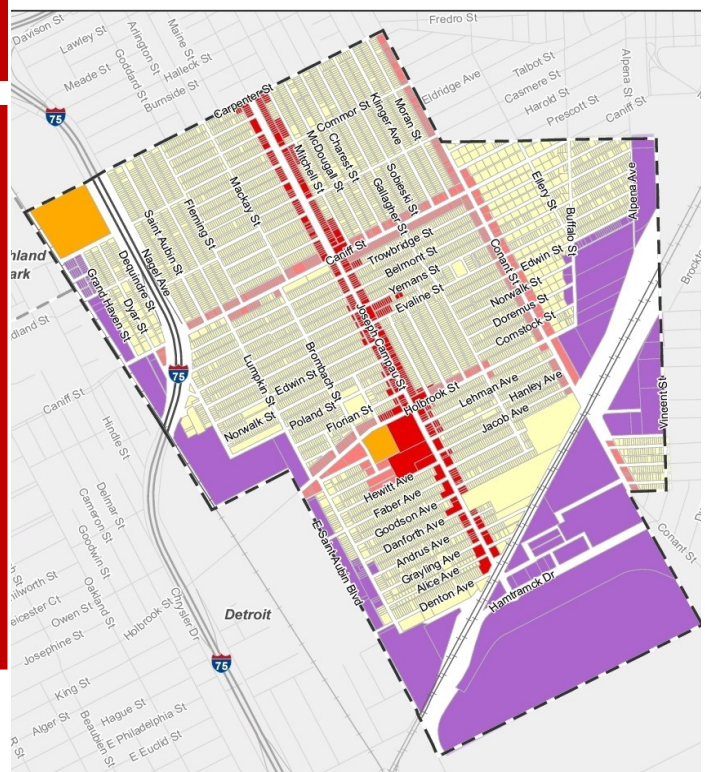

FEES AND POLICIES

Business Hours: Monday - Friday 8:00 a.m. - 9:30 p.m.

WHO RECEIVES THE RESIDENT RATE?

- ⇒ Lives in Hamtramck **OR**
- ⇒ Enrolled in a Hamtramck Public School **OR**
- ⇒ Works in the Hamtramck Public School district

Proof of residency, employment, or school enrollment is required. Only the person who lives in Hamtramck, or attends/works in the HPS district benefits from the resident rate.

REFUND POLICY

- Full refund will be given if a program is cancelled by the department. **You must collect your funds or use it as a credit within two weeks of being notified.**
- Refunds may be issued up until the start of the second class day, minus a \$5 processing fee, which can be used as a credit to enroll in another program if used the day refund is given.
- Refunds for field trips will only be given one (1) week prior to scheduled trip date minus a \$5 processing fee
 - **If trip date is on the weekend, refund can be requested no later than the Friday before the one (1) week mark**
- Refunds will not be issued after the start of the second day of the any given program.
- Refunds are not given if class is cancelled due to weather, school closings, or scheduling conflicts. The department will do its best to offer make-up classes.

FITNESS CENTER AGES 16+

Offers free weights, weight machines, ellipticals, treadmills, and exercise bikes. Proper workout attire is required for the fitness center. The department has the right to refuse anyone who is inappropriately dressed. Ages 16-17 (with membership) must be accompanied by an adult.


